Dual Enrollment/Dual Credit Academic Recommendation Form

A student who is currently attending high school may register to take courses under Mississippi State University's Dual Enrollment/Dual Credit agreement provided he/she:

- has earned 14 core Carnegie units or has a composite score of 30 or higher on the ACT
- has maintained a minimum overall 3.00 grade point average (GPA) on a 4.0 scale on all high school courses as documented by an official high school transcript, and
- has received an unconditional written recommendation from the high school principal, counselor or Dual Enrollment/Dual Credit designee as indicated below (with parental permission under separate form.)

(Students must meet the academic and pre-requisite course requirements (i.e. score on a standardized test, etc.) for placement in certain courses.)

Applicants must submit:

1. an application completed online at the link provided solely to the high school representative
2. an official high school transcript with ACT scores noted and
3. completed Parent or Guardian Permission Form
4. completed Consent Form for Disclosure of Educational Records
5. this completed Academic Recommendation Form
