- 1. an application completed online at the link provided solely to the high school representative
- 2. an official high school transcript with ACT scores noted and
- 3. completed Parent or Guardian Permission Form
- 4. completed Consent Form for Disclosure of Educational Records
- 5. this completed Academic Recommendation Form
